Medical History

Individual has completed 27 combat missions totaling 405 combat hours. Subject officer has sustained severe combat stress on two (2) occasions. His first harassing experience took place on 24 May 1945, on his 17th combat mission. His aircraft was severely damaged by enemy fighter attack over the target, and the Right Gunner was seriously wounded. He crash-landed his damaged aircraft at Iwo Jima. His second harassing experience occurred on return from his 27th combat mission on 23 July 1945. Total exhaustion of his fuel supply with resultant dead engines required the crew to abandon the aircraft and bail out over the ocean. All members of the crew were rescued after remaining in the water for two hours. The Flight Engineer was hospitalized for a severe back injury.
